St. Ingbert is located in the Saarpfalz district, in the immediate vicinity of Saarbrücken and near the border with France. St. Ingbert is conveniently located and has its own exit **St. Ingbert/Mitte from the A6** to reach from. ## Conditions of Participation

All Borgward friends are eligible to participate.

### helper

The instructions of the helpers must be followed so that the time frame can be adhered to. Otherwise you may be excluded from the event.

### Driving discipline

The organizer emphasizes that the road traffic regulations (StVO) must be strictly adhered to. Each participant undertakes to exercise a sporting attitude and be fair towards the organizer, his helpers and the other participants.

### Insurance

Each participant is responsible for ensuring that the vehicle they use is properly insured for the duration of the event with at least the minimum level of motor vehicle liability coverage. There is also organizer liability insurance. Liability damages between participants are not insured by the organizer (only through their own insurance).

### Environmental protection

The participants are responsible for ensuring that oil leaking from vehicles and other liquids are prevented from penetrating the ground. You must secure the vehicles with cardboard, shells or something similar. Participants must also dispose of their own waste, including cardboard that was left out to prevent oil from running out.

### Responsibility and waiver of liability of the participants

#### a) Responsibility

Participants take part in the event at their own risk. You bear sole civil and criminal responsibility for all damage caused by you or the vehicle you use, unless there is no exclusion of liability under this notice.

exercise is agreed. If the driver is not himself the vehicle owner and holder of the vehicle he is using, he also

releases the group of people named in 'Liability waiver b)' below from any claims of the vehicle owner and holder and, in connection with the naming, issues a corresponding waiver from the vehicle owner or vehicle holder.

#### b) Waiver of liability

The participants waive their entry by submitting their entry for everyone in connection with the event

- ◆ any right of action or recourse against any accident or damage that occurs
- ◆ the organizer, its representatives, sports marshals or helpers
- ◆ Authorities and any other persons associated with the organization of the event, provided that the accident or damage is not due to intent or negligence.

This insurance becomes effective against Ciber when everyone involved in the event is nominated.

### Responsibility of the organizer

The organizer reserves the right to make any necessary changes to the announcement due to force majeure or for security reasons or ordered by the authorities or to cancel the event if this is due to extraordinary circumstances, without incurring any claims for damages. In this case, the organizer is only liable if an exclusion of liability has not been agreed upon in the advertisement and entry.
