

The meeting takes place at about 15 minutes drive from Brussels, in Waterloo, some 10 Km south of Brussels.

The meeting starts in the inner court yard from “Martin’s Grand Hotel “
Chaussée de Tervuren 198 - 1410 Waterloo (Brussel)

Route description :

From Antwerp :

Follow E19 towards Brussels.

On the Brussels ringway, follow Bergen/Charleroi/Waterloo (22Km). Take exit 28 “Argenteuil/Waterloo”, and continue straight on. Follow “Chaussée de Tervuren” for 1Km till Nr 198. The Hotel is situated at your left hand side.

From Ghent :

Follow E40 towards Brussels.

On the Brussels ringway, follow Bergen/Charleroi/E19 (23Km).

Take exit 22 “Tubize/Waterloo”. Go left at “Chaussée de Tubize” towards “Waterloo/Braine-l’Alleud”. Follow this road for 4.5 Km till the roundabout..

Now straight on for 2Km on the “Chaussée de Bara”, till the roundabout.

Again go straight on towards “La Hulpe”. After 2 Km, go left to the “Chaussée de Tervuren” at the roundabout.

The hotel is some 100m down the road at your right hand side.

From Leuven :

Follow E40 towards Brussels.

On the Brussels ringway, follow Bergen/Charleroi/Waterloo (17Km). Take exit 28

“Argenteuil/Waterloo”, and continue straight on. Follow “Chaussée de Tervuren” for 1Km till Nr 198. The Hotel is situated at your left hand side.

Dear Borgward friends,

We invite you, your family and your friends for our 30th International Annual Meeting for Borgward, Goliath, Hansa and Lloyd enthusiasts.

For this Jubilee meeting, we have chosen for Waterloo, in the Brabant Walloon Province, near Brussels, with amongst others a visit to the lion of Waterloo and the Villers la Ville abbey.

Waterloo 1815 is a key moment in Europe's history. This is where the last of a long series of bloody battles was fought between Napoleon's French army and the European coalition troops, formed between England, the Netherlands and Prussia, but today, Waterloo is a quiet little village, with nice boutiques and several museums.

We'll visit "The Lion of Waterloo", a giant statue that commemorates the battle, and which was built by King Willem of the "Verenigd Koninkrijk der Nederlanden". The monument depicts a gigantic Lion on an artificial hill, some 45m above the surrounding area. We will also visit the Panorama (a cylindrical painting of 12 meter high and 110 meter long) that shows a view on the battle scene near Waterloo.

The Ruins of the Villers La Ville abbey are also linked to France and Napoleon and worth to be visited.

The abbey was founded in 1146, as an extension of the French Clairvaux abbey, and reached its peak in the 13th century with a community of over 100 monks, 300 lay brothers, and over 10.000 ha of land, spread from Antwerp to Namur. The abbey was abandoned when the French army expelled the monks in 1796, and the buildings were partly dismantled to be sold as recycled construction materials. With its length of 94m and 23m high arches, the abbey church is still the most impressive construction on the ruin fields.
